- Blanket, (chew) toys
- 8 Pet travel basket, collar, leash, muzzle, poop bags, filling for cages, cleaning wipes

Just like people, pets can also be affected by a disaster or crisis. It's important to be aware of the risks and the preparations you can make. Talk to those around you about what you can do to ensure everyone's safety, including your pets. Putting together an emergency kit is quite simple. And consider the following four steps. Being prepared gives you a sense of security and safety, both for yourself and your loved ones.

Shelter

Arrange a place for you and your pet to stay. Discuss with family and friends beforehand whether you can stay with them.



Vaccinations

Make sure your pet is properly vaccinated and include a copy of its vaccination record in your emergency kit.

Identification

Make sure your pet can be identified, preferably with a microchip. Also, make sure registration is correct and your pet is registered in your name and address.





Transport

Think about how you can transport your pet and who can help you. Are you using a carrier? Make sure your pet is used to it.
